School Uniform

As the inclement weather continues, please ensure that your child(ren) have suitable water-proof and warm clothing and footwear to protect them during school hours.

Please note that, as we start to think about preparing school uniforms for next session **starting in August 2023**, **black canvas shoes/dark trainers will be required to be worn indoors**, and indoor shoes such as sliders or slippers will no longer be acceptable due to health and safety and hygiene reasons.
