Internet Safety Parent/Carer Session

We will be hosting a parent/carer information session focusing on children and their online/social media access and how to stay safe online. Leeanne Turner, our former Child Protection expert within City of Edinburgh Council, will be presenting this very informative session which will help parents and carers navigate their way through the extremely difficult processes of allowing children access to online content. The session will be held on **Wednesday 15th May 2024 at 6pm – 7.15pm** in the school hall and all parents and carers are welcome.



Please see the introduction below from Leeanne:

Leeanne Turner has over 20 years' experience as a social worker within the field of child protection. She has been a child protection trainer for 10 years. She is also a CEOP ambassador and supports professionals and parents to think about the risks online and how to work proactively with children and young people to keep them safe. Leeanne is also a mum to a 15-year-old social media obsessed girl and so knows well the peer pressure and worries that parents can find themselves in when it comes to their children's online world.

This parents workshop will explore what some of the current risks are as well as signposting to resources that parents can use to keep themselves informed about their child's virtual world. We will look at all ages from early years up to adolescents. There will be an opportunity for discussion and questions throughout the session.

Plastic Free Friday!

A message from our Eco-Committee:

As part of our mission towards our <u>7th Eco Flag</u>, the Eco Committee are promoting Plastic Free Friday. On Fridays we are encouraging pupils to bring in a plastic free snack (a snack without a plastic wrapper) or a snack in a reusable tub. This is not mandatory but helps reduce our single-use-plastic waste.



On a Friday as pupils leave for break, class teachers will count how many plastic free snacks they see on the way out. The class with the highest percentage of plastic free snacks enjoy a small reward the following week.

As an eco-school we are always looking for ways to become more sustainable and we thank you for your help in doing so!

Wildlife Garden

Our wildlife garden, which is located at the rear of our main playground, is taking shape, with many of our gardening group's plans coming to life. The garden will be used by both Fox Covert and St. Andrew's Primary Schools as a learning environment that will enhance and develop our outdoor learning curriculum, and will also create a quieter space in the playground that can be



used for a variety of learning and teaching inputs. We currently have our newly built fence installed which has zoned the garden area, and we have natural wooden tunnels created that are already coming to life with buds and leaves. Important Reminders

Children's safety is our top priority, and pets can be unpredictable around children.

All parents/carers please ensure that your child(ren) **do not bring** any of the following food items to school as they can present serious hazards to themselves and/or others:

Lollipops with stick attached

Nuts of any kind (we have a growing number of children with nut allergies and any contact can have extremely serious consequences)

Any form of Nutella products (as they contain nuts)

Please be mindful of the following if these are brought to school:









^{**}Please ensure that pets are <u>not</u> brought to the school playground or at any drop-off/pick-up locations around the school.**





Cereal bars (as they can contain nuts – please check the nutrition information)

Small tomatoes & grapes – Recent guidance from our Early Years team has advised that small tomatoes and grapes should be cut in quarters rather than halves, as when halved they can still pose a risk. Please ensure these are cut into small pieces, as these can be serious choking hazards for children if not cut.

Please ensure that **no fizzy juice** is given for packed lunch and please have **water only in class water bottles.**

Parking:

<u>Please note that the school car park is designated for staff parking only.</u>
<u>Unfortunately, the school campus does not have a large enough car park to accommodate parking for parents/carers.</u>



The car park cannot be used for dropping pupils off or picking pupils up from Out of School Clubs either.
