Update from Mr Bruce

- Thank you for the panto funding (funded by the Parent Council). The pupils enjoyed the experience, but we are looking to do something out with school next year.
- The present room was a great success and enjoyed by the children.
- A parent group has now been identified to gather views for new school build – next meeting planned for 24 Feb.
- Thank you to Sarah for securing £2,000 from Virgin Money – this will be used to buy stylus sets, keyboards, headphones, connectors for the school tablets.
- March 17 Tempest photographer will be in school taking individual OR sibling photos. Unfortunately, we can't accommodate including nursery siblings.
- A self-evaluation Local Authority visit is planned for April – likely to be 23 or 24 April – if any parents would like to join a focus group that would be appreciated.
- Netball is now open to P5, P6 and P7 pupils
- Blue container in the playground is no longer needed so it has been removed.
- Request for Bikeability volunteers – please email admin school office if interested. Training will be over one or two Friday afternoons at a local primary school. We are looking for 3 or 4 volunteers to do a morning or afternoon session once or twice a year.
- Issues with parking – lots of people using the car park for drop-offs. The school are letting the police know car registrations.
- The school's Anti-Bullying and Learning, Teaching and Assessment policies have been updated – looking for a small focus group of parents to review and comment on the policies.
- There will be 11 classes next year (2026/2027 academic year)
- Staff absences over last 6 weeks have been challenging, with Senior Leadership Staff covering teaching classes.

- Staff are running clubs this term. Miss Doddie has organised P6s and P7 to attend Murrayfield golf club.
- Maria (P1 Assistant) is going on maternity leave this week.
- All P7s have successfully applied for leadership opportunities at the school. Roles included Library Assistants, Corridor Monitors, and Kindness Captains.
- P6s are taking part in Euro Quiz heats. If they get through to the final, it will be held in McEwan Hall.
- P5s are working hard as part of their Scottish Opera workshop – based on The Dragon of the Western Seas – thank you to Brooke for securing funding for this.
- People's Voice Toolkit and Foxy Rights Rangers – parent helpers will be asked to come in – Miss Doddie will be in touch.
- Would like to send P6s on an epic day which will give children an experience of outdoor learning before residential camp. Run by Edinburgh City Council - £42 per pupil, currently 42 P6s. The school would be looking to do this every year going forward. The PC agreed to cover half per child (£21 per child).
